

West of England Coach Bursaries

There is a total budget of £5000

The funding will be targeted at converting Level 1 coaches to Level 2

The bursary will fund 50% of the cost of a qualification, excluding affiliation, Insurance and CRB costs.

The aim of the bursaries will be to increase the number of coaching hours being delivered therefore targeting coaches that are looking to coach 3 hours plus a week.

The application will be processed via the CoachWest Coach Bursary management system.

Bursaries will be paid on the successful completion of the course and production of the certificate.

There will be two phases to the process

Phase 1 – Online application – assessed by Coach Development Group

Phase 2 – Club/Coach visit by Coaching Development Officer – bursary awarded if successful at this stage

Phase 3 – Follow up visit after qualification to gather publicity and verify activities are now happening

Bursaries will be launched every 3 months with a budget of £1000 per application round. Four rounds will be announced which should leave us with an under spend. This will allow us to overspend if necessary and to also add a further round at the end of the year.

All applicants that make it through phase 1 will receive a free place at the next Coach Development day.
