



CODE OF CONDUCT PARENTS/GUARDIANS

We are fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well being of all participants, coaches, volunteers, parents, staff and all those associated with Wesport activities.

It is important that all those involved should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the welfare of others.

The essence of good ethical conduct is summarised below:-.

As the parent /guardian you will be expected to abide by the following Code of conduct.

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of participants, teachers, coaches, volunteers, staff, officials and their decisions.
- Ensure that, both you and your child adhere to the Wesport Code of Conduct, Child Protection Policy and any NGB or other Partner relevant policies.
- Place the safety and well being of all participants above the development of performance.
- Ensure that your child arrives for the session at the required time and with the appropriate kit/equipment.
- Ensure that you collect your child promptly at the end of each session and advise the person in charge if your child will need to leave the activity early or, if your child will be picked up by someone other than yourself.
- Pay any fees for your child's activity promptly (unpaid fees will result in your child not being allowed to access sessions).
- Support your child's involvement, help them enjoy their activity and be a good sport.
- Ensure that your child participates for fun and not just to please you or the coach.
- Share any concerns or complaints about any aspect of the activity through the approved channels.
- Endeavour to establish good communications with those in charge of the activity.
- Ensure that the person in charge of the activity and/or the Coach or their representative is informed of illness/injury/medical

condition/disability/Special education needs that your child may have prior to the start of the warm up.

- Ensure that the coach or person in charge of the activity or their representative is informed if your child cannot attend training sessions.
- All Parents /Guardians should use correct and proper language at all times and should discourage anyone from challenging/arguing with coaches/volunteers/staff/officials.
