## Minimum Standards for Deployment - Coaching

The criteria identified below are the recommended minimum standards that a coach should hold in order to coach on their own in a lead role capacity.

- **Appropriately qualified Instructor / Coach**  
*In most cases this will be a **National Governing Body Level 2 Coaching Award**. There are certain sports that will allow Level 1 coaches to operate on their own with certain level groups - in this instance the coach or 'Delivery Organisation' should provide proof of this to the Wesport Project Manager*
- **Insurance** *Minimum £5 million Public Liability Insurance held by the 'Delivery Organisation' and their preferred coach/instructor*
- Up to date 'Enhanced' DBS check - within last three years for all deliverers
- Up to date First aid qualification held by the coach / instructor leading the satellite club session
- **Minimum 18 years of age for those leading the session**

**ALSO:** If coaching children (under 18 years of age) ONE of the following additional criteria will be required:

- **3 hour UK Coaching Safeguarding and Protecting Children Workshop**
- **A National Governing Body (NGB) approved course**
- **Local Safeguarding Children's Board (LSCB) Level 2 course**

*Attendance at a recognised Safeguarding and Protecting Children workshop within the last three years is required by anyone leading or assisting with the delivery of the satellite club.*
