However, we recognise that relevant safeguards need to be put in place by organisations to ensure children and young people remain safe whilst online or using social media.

We ask that all teachers/parents/carers/volunteers/deliverers/participants spend a few minutes to read through this policy

I will be responsible for my behaviour when using the internet and other online media at the event including the resources I access and my use of language.

- I will not use social networking or the internet to send anyone material that could be considered threatening, offensive, upsetting, bullying or illegal.
- I will not post inappropriately on social media sites.
- I understand that my use of the internet and other online media at this event can be monitored, logged and made available to relevant authorities
- I will not give out any of my personal information such as name, age, address or telephone number.
- I will not share my passwords with anyone else.
- I will not arrange to meet someone unless accompanied by a member of staff or parent/carer.
- I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and if they are not followed those in authority will be contacted.
