What's happening at Wesport?

- Our resident tutor and Workforce Manager Richard delivered the first of two online 'First Steps into Coaching' workshops virtually. In partnership with colleagues at Access Sport, these sessions aim to give a group of their volunteers some training support during lockdown. This will directly help with their volunteer roles when they are able to work on projects in the future.

- Satellite Club partners have re-purposed their funding to support participants who want to keep active at home during lockdown. Frenchay Falcons Super 1's Hub (as seen above!) with GCB and Martin Berrill Sports used funding to buy equipment to send directly to participants homes.

- Local partners have accessed <u>Step Up funding</u> to help them deliver activity to their communities. Urban Dance in Hartcliffe used funding towards a speaker system to help record sessions for their live dance broadcasts. You can still apply for this fund <u>here</u>.

Sport England Emergency Community Fund

- Over £12million of the <u>Sport England Community Emergency Fund</u> has so far been distributed to over 3000 clubs and community organisations and over 7500 applications have been received in total. 51 applications have been approved in the West of England, totalling £195,000.
