Bath City FC Foundation & Young Bristol will deliver the Youth Club On Wheels, a mobile youth service working with young people aged 8+ to provide positive activities and support for young people at risk of becoming involved with crime or anti-social behaviour.

This new project will strengthen the community by enabling coaches from Bath City Football Foundation and Young Bristol staff to engage and support vulnerable young people following the lockdown period.

Activities Include...

- Sports and games. (E.g badminton, football, and cricket, mini golf, giant Jenga, basket balls, rugby balls, ping pong.)
- A safe place to talk and discuss issues.
- Guidance and support.
- A place to relax and socialise with friends and trusted adults outside of school hours.

This partnership will work closely with police, local authorities, parish councils, community groups and local people to deliver activity in priority areas.
